


## TANK DIVIDERS - SILICONE INSTALL

If everything looks good then test fit the divider in your tank before removing the protective film. If everything fits up well then remove the protective film and install.

To install, drop the divider into the tank and rotate it into place. Once in place, seal around the front and back edges with aquarium safe silicone. To hold the divider in place while you silicone you can use a dab or two of cyanoacrylate glue (super glue, corafix, etc.) along the bottom edge. Allow 24 hours to cure before adding water. "Aquarium Safe" silicone can be purchased from most aquarium stores and many of the major online retailers who stock aquarium supplies. 100% pure silicone like GE Type I from the local big box stores is also considered "Aquraium safe". Do not use any silicone with additives like anti-fungal agents (GE Type II or similar).

Due to variations in tank manufacturing there will be a gap between the glass and the divider when it is installed perpendicular to the walls and bottom. This is perfectly normal. That gap should not exceed 1/8" along any edge. If you feel the gap is too wide for your application please contact us and we'll work with you to correct the issue.
